RE: HKBN embraces Net Neutrality \ Invitation to Netflix to come to Hong Kong

Hong Kong Broadband Network (HKBN) is a new entrant and the largest symmetric 100Mbps and above residential internet service provider in Hong Kong. Unlike many legacy incumbents around the world, we embrace Over-The-Top (OTT) content as we consider this to be an essential part of the ecosystem in the fiber era of unlimited bandwidth constraints.

As such, we hereby extend a direct invitation for Netflix to formally launch your services here in Hong Kong. We will facilitate direct local access to our fiber network without bandwidth throttling such that Hong Kong customers can enjoy 4K HD Netflix innovation as the norm rather than exception.

We are proud to lead Hong Kong to a global leadership position, with our city rated as the highest Average Peak Connection Speed destination in the World by Akamai's Q4, 2013 State of the Internet Report; Hong Kong is rated at 65Mbps and for reference, HKBN at 87Mbps, US at 44Mbps and Global at 23 Mbps.

Hong Kong can certainly do with a new "House of Cards".
