Hong Kong Broadband Unveils Travel Data SIM Card Just \$55 a Day for Easy Access in 39 Regions Worldwide

(Hong Kong, 19 March 2015) Hong Kong Broadband Network Limited ("HKBN") today announced the launch of its all new "Travel Data SIM Card" *. Offered at a flat rate of just \$55 per day, the SIM Card brings unparalleled value and convenient data access in 39 regions throughout the world so that customers can enjoy the benefits of round-the-clock mobile Internet connection, whenever they travel.

Online purchase with convenient doorstep delivery

With ordering made easy, HKBN customers can purchase the Travel Data SIM Cards by simply logging on to traveldata.hkbn.net. To meet the needs of any travel itinerary, customers may purchase the SIM Card with a onetime payment of \$30, and enjoy the use of 150MB of data at \$55 per day. For customers who purchase more than one day of service, the total data volume bought is flexibly available for cumulative consumption, removing the confinement of same-day consumption capped at 150MB. Customers may, at their own discretion, choose to use their data allotment all in one go or over the duration of their travels. Once the online order has been confirmed, the Travel Data SIM Card will be delivered to registered correspondence address of the customers. In addition, new or existing HKBN customers who wish to enjoy the superb value of the SIM Card can choose from a number of broadband service plans that include a Travel Data SIM Card when registering as a new user or renewing service contract.

Charged on a rolling 24-hour basis instead of per calendar day

Once the SIM has been activated and connected to the local network, mobile data service comes into effect. Unlike other data SIM cards available on the market, HKBN's Travel Data SIM Card does not charge on a restrictive calendar day basis that begins daily at 12am midnight, instead service is calculated on a rolling 24-hour basis, starting from the time the Travel Data SIM Card is first connected to the Internet and ending 24 hours thereafter. Essentially, each single-day charge provides customers with unhindered data service even during travels to multiple countries within a 24-hour period. Each Travel Data SIM Card can provide service up to a maximum of 30 effective days. Introducing new levels of flexibility to the marketplace, consecutive-day usage is not a requirement of the Travel Data SIM Card. With no expiry date, customers can now enjoy using the SIM Card and its entitled days of service, whether consecutively or intermittently, according to their own needs. Top up of the SIM Card can also be done conveniently online any time.

One SIM Card for 39 regions

HKBN's Travel Data SIM Card provides unhindered access across different 39 regions, comprising **Asia Pacific**: Taiwan, Japan, South Korea, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Indonesia, Australia, New Zealand; **North America**: United States and Canada; **Europe**: United Kingdom, France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, Austria, the Netherlands, Belgium, Greece, Finland, Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan Azerbaijan, Belarus, Ireland, Moldova, Croatia, Estonia, Latvia Lithuania, Ukraine; and **others**: Russia, South Africa, Ghana. Each SIM will come packaged in a handy, compact jacket with easy-to-understand instructions. And in keeping with HKBN's pledge to do more for our customers, beginning in April, each purchase will include a credit card sized SIM Card holder. The nifty custom design features four pockets to store SIM cards in various sizes, as well as a purpose-made metallic pin to help iPhone users conveniently remove their SIMs.
