SCHOOL LOCATIONS

DELHI, INDIA

The National Capital Territory of Delhi (Delhi for short) is the heart of the India's national government. It is a sprawling and lively urban center, containing almost 25 cities and neighborhoods and a population of 16.8 million. Delhi has served as the seat of many of the rulers of India, and is the largest commercial center in northern India with a focus on information technology, telecommunications, hotels, banking, media and tourism. At the region's center is New Delhi, one of the fastest growing cities in the world, with much of its population gain due to relocation from other states in India. Although the official literacy rate for Delhi is 86%, female literacy rates hover below male rates, which are 81% and 91% respectively. Although these rates are relatively high compared to the rest of the country, it is estimated that about half



of Delhi's residents live in slums, resulting in wide disparities in educational access and quality across the region.

CA MAU, VIETNAM

Ca Mau province is the southernmost province in Vietnam. With a population of 1.2 million people it is the second largest province in the Mekong Delta, covering almost 13% of the region. Bordered by sea on three sides, fishing is an important industry in the province. An extensive network of canals also supports strong agriculture and aquaculture sectors, with rice and shrimp being the two main products cultivated in Ca Mau. Seventy seven percent of the province's population lives in rural areas across the Ca Mau's mainland and territorial waters and often face difficult living conditions due to the remote nature of much of the province. Of the 259 primary schools in Ca Mau, only 124 schools meet national standards for education quality, and all of the



schools are in need of quality library interventions to improve children's literacy.

LAM DONG, VIETNAM

Lam Dong Province is located in the South Central Highland region of Vietnam and has a geography comprised of mountains and plateaus. The junction of the Dong Nai River, which is an exchange point of many cultures, is located in the province, making this a region with inhabitants from many different backgrounds. The economy in Lam Dong is based largely on agriculture with tea, coffee and vegetables being the main agricultural products. There is widespread poverty throughout the region with 13% of the population living under the poverty line, which is double the national poverty rate. The areas in which Room to Read works have a high number of students from minority ethnic groups.



These students face extra challenges including language barriers and cultural beliefs that do not place importance on education.

LIBRARY TYPE DETAILS

SEPARATE

Separate libraries are established in a dedicated school room that is used solely as a library. This is often an unused storage space or teacher's office. The library is stocked with books, shelving and furniture, and is designed to ensure children can easily access the library's resources. The walls are covered in maps, student work and educational posters to make the library inviting. Students may visit the library during break time, before and after school and during designated library periods.

TEACHER/LIBRARIAN TRAINING

Room to Read provides all librarians and teachers involved with our libraries with a minimum of three days of training in the first year of our support, and one to two days of refresher training in both the second and third years. These trainings build on each other and align with the library's stage of development. We also support educators by providing direct coaching and program implementation feedback during regular library monitoring visits. Our team assesses the quality of the library through a rating tool, which evaluates the library across 16 indicators. Room to Read staff use these ratings to determine the frequency and type of support we provide.

COUNTRY & GLOBAL LITERACY PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

SYSTEMIC CHANGE: IMPROVING LITERACY LEARNING BEYOND OUR PROJECT SCHOOLS

Your investment in our programs has allowed Room to Read to demonstrate high quality education initiatives with measurable results. Our ability to execute quality programs at scale has gained the recognition of local and national governments as well as other nonprofits, who want to partner with us to promote widespread educational policy and curriculum changes. The following is a highlight of some of these partnerships, focused on improving literacy learning for children broadly. We greatly value your investment in our work and make every effort to leverage your support for maximum benefit for the children in the schools you supported, and far beyond! With your help and that of partners around the world, we can solve the challenge of illiteracy — in our lifetime.

INDIA

Room to Read began piloting literacy instruction activities in India in 2008. These activities are now a core component of our Literacy Program, and Grade 2 students in our India program can read three times as many words per minute as their peers in non-program schools. Recognizing this achievement, the state governments of Uttarakhand and Chhattisgarh invited us to implement our early grade literacy instruction work at scale for five academic years. In 2015, we began a pilot project in 360 primary schools across the two states, and are working to build the states' systemic capabilities so they can implement effective literacy interventions independently in the future. These efforts will benefit close to 4 million children over time.

VIETNAM

Vietnam became Room to Read's second country of operation in 2001. We have worked closely with Vietnam's government since our launch, and this partnership led to the creation of a "Friendly Primary Library Program" in 2015, through which are working to replicate our library model nationally. As a first step in this program, in 2016 we established 40 model libraries in the provinces of Dak Lak and Ha Tinh and trained government staff in library management. We will implement model libraries in five additional provinces through 2018, and the government will begin establishing their own replicas of our libraries. We also supported the provinces of Vinh Long and Tra Vinh in 2016 to integrate our library rating system into their criteria for evaluating school libraries.

GLOBAL RESEARCH, MONITORING & EVALUATION

We conduct ongoing research, monitoring and evaluation to ensure that we are providing communities with the highest quality educational programs. This includes annual data collection on each of our projects, which is then analyzed to measure and improve the impact of our work. Following are some of the highlights from our 2017 program analysis, which is the most recent year that we have completed analyzing.

Improving Reading Skills

We have consistently found that children in classrooms where we support literacy instruction read significantly more fluently than children in nearby comparison schools. In 2017, we completed assessments of Grade 2 students' reading skills in nine languages. For five of these languages (Lao, Sepedi, Khmer, Hindi, and Swahili) our evaluations also included comparison students in non-Room-to-Read schools. Across these languages, students in Room to Read classrooms read nearly twice as fast (an average of 96% more correct words per minute) as their peers in other schools by the end of Grade 2.

Another key metric for the effectiveness of our program is the prevalence of *zero scores* on reading comprehension tests — i.e. the percentage of children who, by the end of Grade 2, are still unable to read a single word correctly. On average, the prevalence of zero scores for oral reading fluency is more than 50% lower in Room to Read schools than in comparison schools.

Creating a Habit of Reading

Our Literacy Program seeks to build both *reading skills* and a *habit of reading*. Our key measure of success toward the development of reading habits is the average number of books checked out by each student over the course of the year. In 2017, this indicator rose to 16.6 books per child — the highest level in Room to Read's history. This represents an average of 3,980 books checked out per library in 2017, and more than 14 million books checked out worldwide during the year. Nearly all countries increased their book checkout rates as compared to 2016.

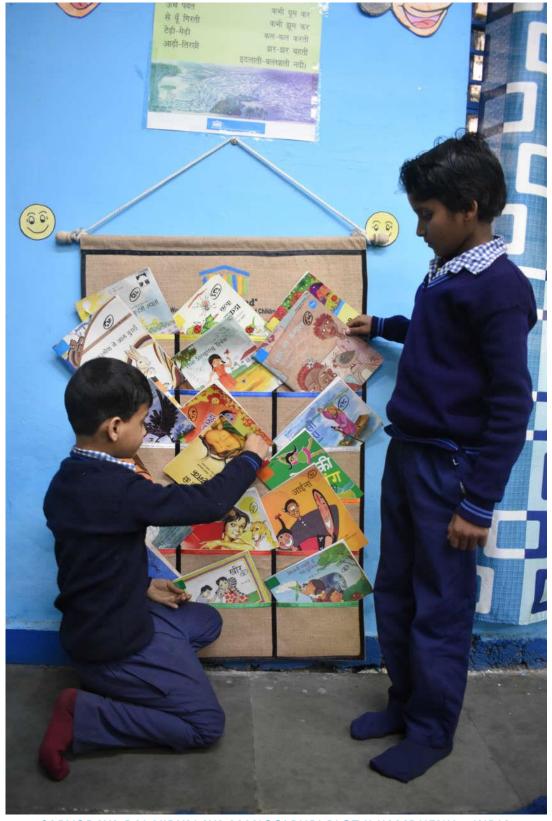

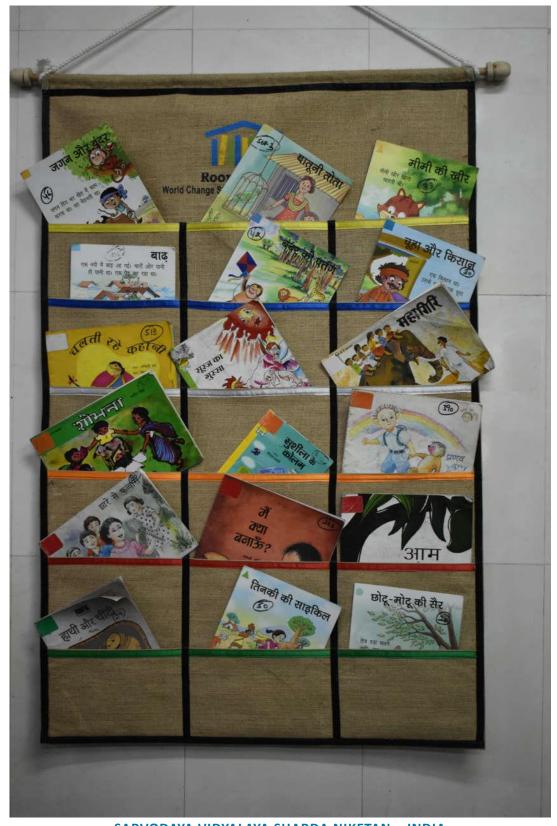

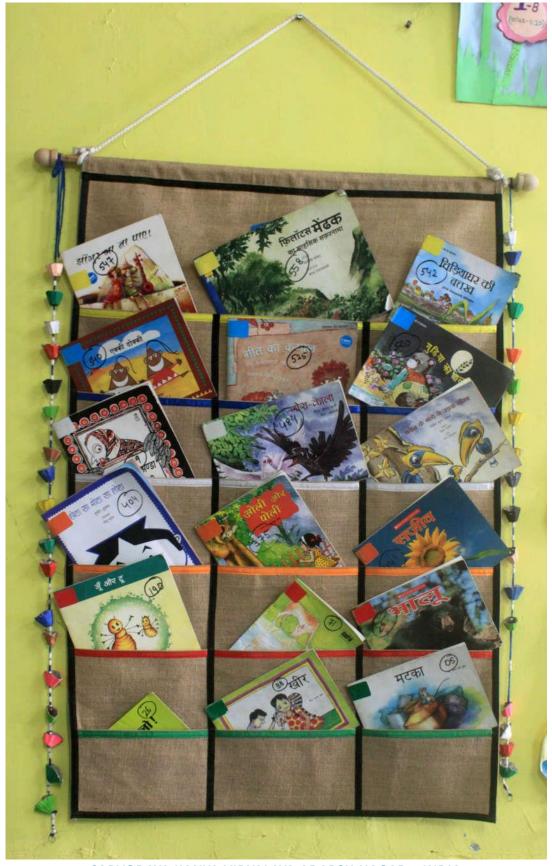
